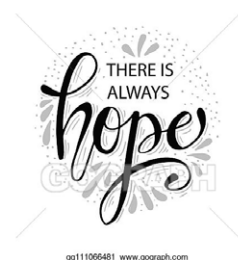

Did you know that the Eastern Shore Region, including Cecil County, has experienced a 35% increase this year in fatal overdoses? This week, Don Mathis, Peer Recovery Specialist, spoke to us about Voices of Hope. This non-profit focuses on harm reduction for persons with substance use disorder.

Their vision is to "end the cycle of addiction, heal families affected by addiction and change the perception of addiction for all" through Peer Recovery Specialists, Harm Reduction Outreach teams, substance use crisis response, recovery friendly events, Narcan training, community clean up of syringes, and many other avenues.

- seed and nut packets
