Tuesday, August 6, 2019

The Rotary Club of Cambridge recently held their weekly meeting at the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad State Park in Church Creek, Md. Dana Paterra, Park Manager, spoke to the membership about the history of the Park Visitor Center as well as some of Harriet Tubman's history. Ms Tubman, a native of Dorchester County, spent much of her life helping slaves reach freedom in the North.

Dana has spent 25 years interpreting natural and cultural resources and 10 years in park operations. She received her bachelor's degree in Environmental Science from the University of Virginia. Her career has taken her from her home in Chincoteague, Va, to St. Charles, Ar, to Charleston, SC and back to the Eastern Shore.
