World Polio Day will be here soon!

What plans do you have in your club for celebrating World Polio Day on October 24th?

One of our polio goals for this Rotary year is for every club in our district to have a polio community awareness event. Many clubs and districts in Zone 33 have used the celebration of World Polio Day as an opportunity for such an event.

The Zone has collected a Tool Kit with information and suggested activities for your club's use to celebrate World Polio Day, and it is now available online. Simply google World Polio Day 2020 and go into the endpolio.org website.

In our current environment, the traditional fundraiser may not be a viable option. In the past, many clubs have had community fundraisers and have written articles for publication in local newspapers about Rotary activities in their communities that address the eradication of the wild polio virus world-wide. Some clubs are planning virtual fundraising auctions, while others are focusing on awareness campaigns like lighting up their local courthouse with purple light and hosting an informative talk nearby.

Most clubs are meeting virtually and have had no expense for meals for several months. It's likely that many have not yet reduced their club dues. One idea is to use some of those extra monies for meeting the polio minimum goal of \$40 per Rotarian.

Rotarians are People of Action. We find ways to meet a challenge. We think out-of-the-box. And we know in District 7670 that we will meet our club and district polio goals this year!
