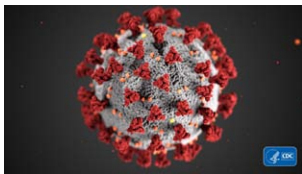

After earning Associates Degrees from Catawba Valley Community College & Blue Ridge Community College, she received her BSN from Mars Hill University.



As the Communicable Disease Lead Nurse managing the Health Department's infectious disease department's day-to-day operations, she works closely with the State Communicable Disease Control Division, the State TB Control Division, and the State Immunization Branch.
