After college, Grant moved to the Monterey Bay area, building a home in Big Sur. Here, along with his good friend Jerry, he founded Morrill and Forbes Chimney Sweeps, performing his duties in a top hat and coat tails, no less. During his time in the Monterey Bay area, he was a banker, a realtor and founded a home repair business. He instilled in his daughter the drive to acquire new skills, to lead with kindness and humor, and to put all you can into the task at hand.

Moving eastward, Grant relocated amongst the Blue Ridge Mountains in Hendersonville. He opened A Well Home Home Inspections and The Second Home Management Company, serving the community with generosity and integrity. It was during this time he met his soulmate, Leslie. A lifelong Rotarian, Grant valued service and giving back the community both in the Monterey Bay Area and Hendersonville.

He was a man with a strong moral compass and empathy, proudly contributing to many community service endeavors throughout his life. Grant was known for his charisma, unflinching sense of humor, and kindness. He will be so deeply missed and all memories of him will be greatly treasured.
