Tour D'Apple Report To Members

Our 8th annual Tour d'Apple cycling event on Labor Day drew 375 cyclists from 12 states to ride up the mountains and around our local apple orchards. We are grateful to Club members and many community volunteers who made the Tour possible and a success on many levels.

In contrast to the cancellations of most cycling and other athletic events in western NC, the TDA went off without a hitch with COVID avoidance and much social distancing.

We expect net profits of approximately \$15,000 for Club and Foundation projects this Rotary year. Amazingly, cyclists more than doubled their extra donations to \$1042 (up from \$500 in 2019). Our District Governor has suggested that the Club designate these extra cyclist donations for winter coats for children in need.

The Tour spent more than \$20,000 at mostly area businesses for tee-shirts, Chick-fil-A sandwiches, printing, rental table, portable toilets, etc. Other payments included contributions of \$600 to the Sheriff's Volunteers in Partnership (VIPs) and \$800 for extra-duty deputies and officers.

And thanks again to our Club members, volunteers, and Idaph Events LLC for making the 8th annual Tour d'Apple a great success. As a postscript, over 90% of TDA cyclists rated their experience as excellent! We have received no reports of virus infections of cyclists or volunteers.
