Polly is the superintendant at Connemara, the national historic home site of poet Carl Sandburg, and gave a history of our National Parks. She explained that in 1914, the Organic Act established the National Park Service to promote and regulate the use of federal areas with Stephen Mather as head. Yellowstone became the first National Park. In the beginning, the service personnel were all big, outdoor type males. That has changed and now many women are employed by the NPS. She said that in 2018, the NPS ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in jobs in the county.
