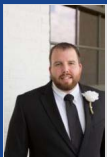



Here are the steps:
