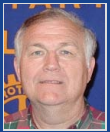

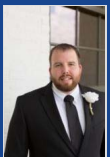


DACdb: Login

DACdb: How to Report a Make-Up

The way we report make-ups is to use DACdb online. It's easy to do and saves the club secretary a great deal of work.

Here are the steps:

1) Log into DACdb and click the My DATA tab
