ADG Billi Black presented Ken Nicholson an honorary pancake apron.

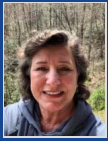
Congrats to Brett Woods for winning the 50/50.

Ron Rhodes informed the club about Vance Davidson and asked us all to wish him a speedy recovery.

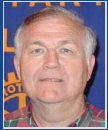
