Rotary Theme for October



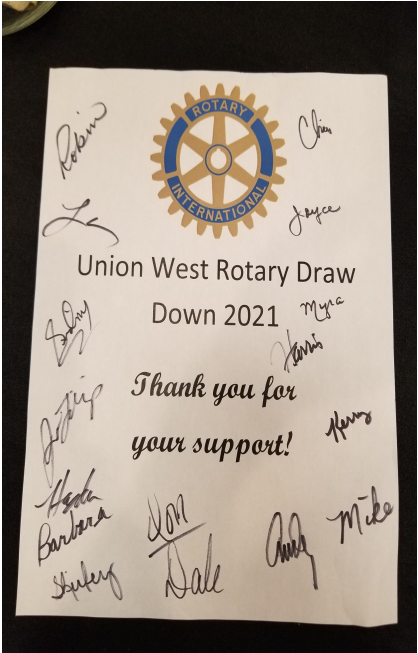
Rotary supports investments in people to create measurable and enduring economic improvement in their lives and communities.
