We enjoyed our weekly meeting #7 of the Rotary year in person at the Indian Trail Town Hall. 20 Rotarians in attendance plus our speaker and 4 guests.

Our scheduled speaker was Warren Cooksey who presented an interesting speech about the 18 mile long Monroe toll road. He spoke about the prepaid QuickPass which offers a 25% discount and is valid in 19 different states.

Use of the toll road continues to grow every year and will save 11-14 minutes as opposed to using RTE 74.
