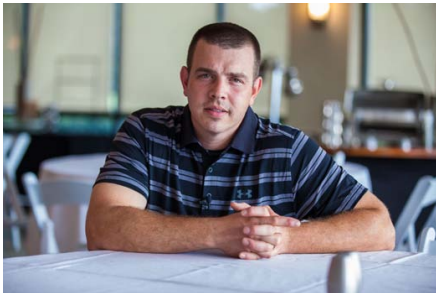
Message from President Daniel Fogarty

Recycle Right presentation on June 5, 2020

You attended a Recycle Right presentation on June 5, 2020

As you know, we cannot offer these in person due to Covid restrictions, but we have successfully been hosting the same presentation via online webinars. We would especially like teachers to tune in, so they can preview it for classroom curriculum in the Fall. We have a technology platform that can easily handle up to 250 attendees.

An interactive presentation and dialogue with Mecklenburg County residents on how to Recycle Right. The program is about 40 minutes, but typically requires an extra 15 minutes for questions. The program includes:


1. An overview of the residential curbside recycling process in Meck county including a 4 minute video that shows close ups of the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) sorting operations.
2. Challenges and costs of improper recycling. How residents can help!
3. What is and is not recyclable.
4. Interactive/fun game to solidify learning and clarify common mis-information.
5. Ample time for audience questions and dialogue.

The presentation will be given by Meck County Residential Recycling Educators, Maitri Meyer & Walker Spruill. They have been a sustainability enthusiasts years and have a strong passion to educate others on reduced consumption and recycling.
