As a Certified Forensic Interviewer, he spent over a decade training investigators globally on the successful application of non-confrontational interview and interrogation techniques. Michael created the Disciplined Listening Method by integrating current business communication research and best practices with non-confrontational interview and interrogation techniques. He teaches participants to activate the truth in the areas of leadership communication, sales, negotiation, conflict resolution, customer service, candidate interviews, family conversations and public speaking.
