On this day in 1949, WBTV TV Channel 3 in Charlotte, NC (CBS) began broadcasting

Trolli created the Gummi Worm on July 15, 1981, possibly in response to the HARIBO gummi bear. Gummi worms are sweet and sour, dual colored and dual flavored. They are served in ice cream, vodka shots, and chocolate cake. They're a key part of the global gummi and jellied candy market that is predicted to reach \$40 billion between 2020 and 2024.

On this day in 1912, Jim Thorpe placed in the top 4 of all 10 events at the 1912 summer Olympics in Stockholm with a record score of 8,413 to win the Decathlon.

WEEKLY PROGRAM: The Butterfly House

Bill Burnside sponsored this week's program about The Butterfly House and began the introduction by thanking Gene Starnes for sponsoring him to join the Rotary Club.

The Butterfly House was founded in 2005, by Amy Calloway Yow (today's presenter). The program offers children who are possible victims of abuse a safe environment to receive emotional and physical support from a team of caring and experienced professionals. Since 2005, the program's staff have cared for over 1,800 children in Stanly, Montgomery, Anson and Richmond counties in North Carolina.

The Butterfly House, which is a department of the hospital, receives referrals from social workers, police officers, schools and healthcare providers. The program also provides education to help children understand Body Safety.

Tiffany Adcock, a nurse practitioner who has volunteered with the program for 8 years, presented additional information and answered questions.

Dr Mindy Turner and Pastor Derrick Adcock ("Team Spirt Filled") will be competing at this year's "Dancing with the Stars" fundraiser event on September 11, 2021 at the Agri-Civic Center, which benefits the Butterfly House. They provided information regarding their upcoming fundraising efforts (Night on 9th, Rocky River Fish House, 31 Bag party, BBQ etc) and the different ways the community can support the event.
