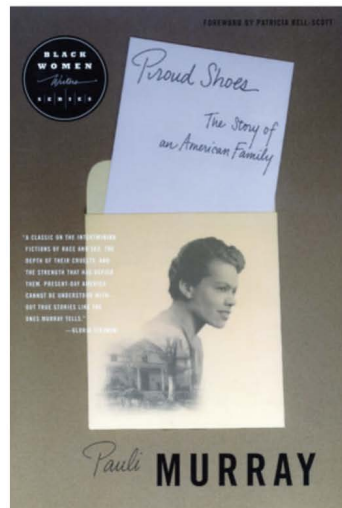

For now, we are using the Book Club to explore issues of race in America. The next book, *Proud Shoes* is by Durham's own Pauli Murray, which we will discuss virtually on September 22nd at 7:00 pm. First published in 1956, *Proud Shoes* is the remarkable true story of slavery, survival, and miscegenation in the South from the pre-Civil War era through the Reconstruction. Written by Pauli Murray the legendary civil rights activist and one of the founders of NOW, *Proud Shoes* chronicles the lives of Murray's maternal grandparents. From the birth of her grandmother, Cornelia Smith, daughter of a slave whose beauty incited the master's sons to near murder to the story of her grandfather Robert Fitzgerald, whose free black father married a white woman in 1840, *Proud Shoes* offers a revealing glimpse of our nation's history.

We need all the help we can get to figure out what we can do. Please come back and help.

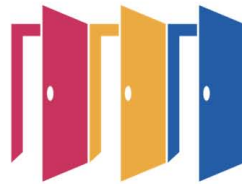
