### Hunter Ingram - Cape Fear Unearthed Podcast

Hunter Ingram is the local history and film industry reporter for the Wilmington Star News. In 2018, he created and began hosting Cape Fear Unearthed, a podcast that explores the persistent legends, historical oddities and landmark stories of Southeastern North Carolina. He is a native North Carolinian, born in Salisbury, and a graduate of East Carolina University. He recently

marked 7 years since moving to Wilmington to write for the Star News

Hunter Ingram is with the Star News and started a podcast called "Cape Fear Unearthed" where he interviews people about local history. Hunter will talk about the origins of his history podcast, how he researches and records the show (before and during quarantine), and what kind of topics the show covers, from the founders that forged this region to the stories that define it. He will also tease what the show will feature in the coming months.

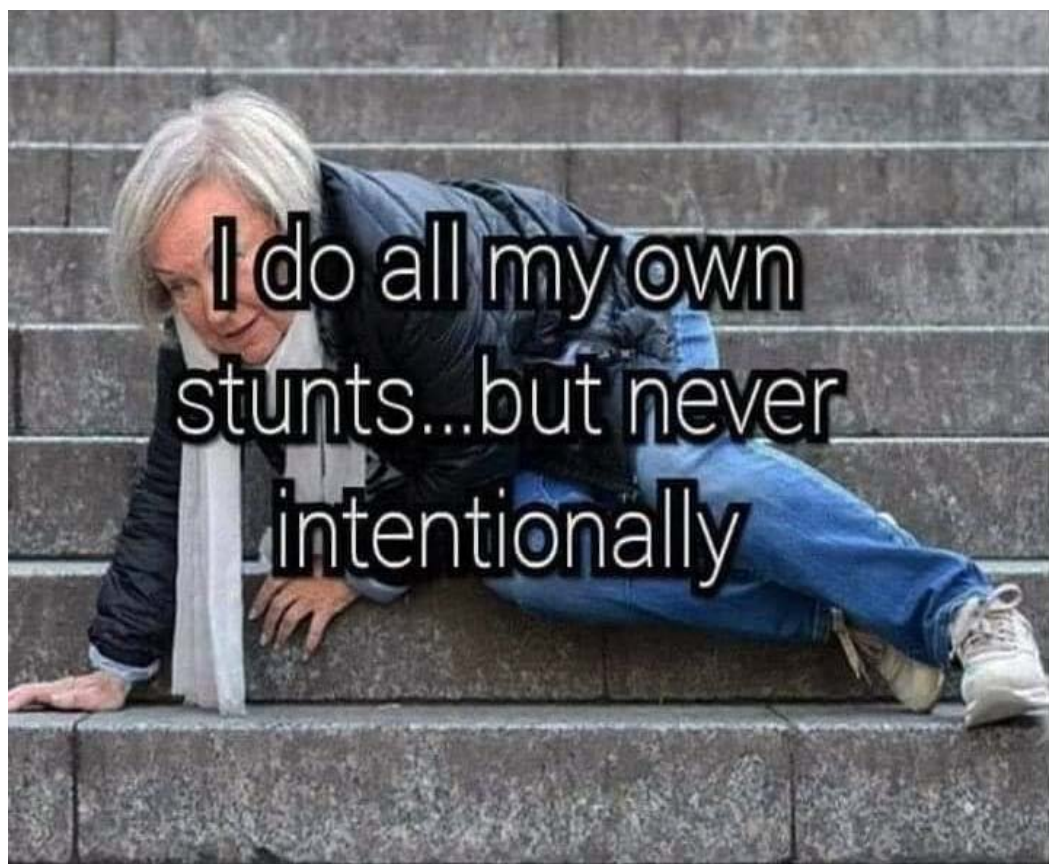
