- The SOM and parents are guests of the Service Committee. The SOM and parents are invited to attend the entire meeting. The specific club meeting agenda may have to be arranged so that the presentation is early in the meeting if the student has to return to school for classes. The SOM Project Manager or otherclub official makes the presentation to the student. The student is given a brief opportunity to say something about themselves or their work.
