With our meetings returning to Tamers in person, we are relearning some things that have slid for expediency during Covid. The first is the MEETING GREETER. As you may, or may not recall, this is an alphabetical assignment and is shown in the Wheels in Motion sidebar. If you are not attending the meeting in person, it is your responsibility to find a substitute and let the club president know who the substitute will be. Depending upon how you negotiate the deal, you and the substitute can swap greeter assignment days, or the substitute can just fill in for you.

In addition to stream of conscious ramblings, I will use this forum to keep the club membership up to date with various issues and topics. This week's topic is club goals posted with Rotary International. At the end of each year, RI requires the club president to identify goals. The president personalizes his/her and the Board's overall club direction with the selection of which goals to pursue. Out of the (round number) many specific sub-goals in 13 categories (club membership, service participation, membership, leadership development, annual fund contributions, polio plus contributions, service projects, interact clubs, strategic plan, online presence, update website and social media, media stories about club projects, and use of official Rotary promotional materials) that I could have entered, these are the 2021-2022 goals:

- SBIR will have 65 members by year end.
- Fifteen SBIR members will participate in ten service projects.
- SBIR will induct one new member. Actually, this is incorrect since as of today, we need six new members to obtain the total membership goal.
- SBIR will have two members attend District 7730's conference and one member attend District 7730's training assembly.
- SBIR membership will donate \$25,000 to the Rotary International Foundation and \$2,600 to Polio Plus.
- I did not identify how many students SBIR would send to Rotary Youth Leadership (RYLA) since I was not sure if RYLA would be held in 2021-2022. I would hope that we send at least two students to RYLA if it is held.
- SBIR has a strategic plan. Last year's is already in the DACdb public files but this will be the primary topic for the next Board meeting.
- SBIR's online presence reflects our current activities.
- SBIR will weekly update the club's website and social media.
