Turner started in the Civil Process Division and then transferred into Uniform Patrol, where he reached the rank of sergeant. He continued to work in patrol until 2006. In 2006, he was promoted to Lieutenant over Training. While leading the training division, Turner worked very hard to ensure the office was provided with quality and effective training, and in 2011 he was promoted to Captain. Turner continues to run the Training Division along with other collateral duties.

Grieving in isolation complicated and lonely. Lower Cape Fear LifeCare (LCFL) is incredibly grateful for South Brunswick Islands Rotary Club's support of our virtual Children's Grief Care Program. You are making sure that nobody is left to feel hopeless or lonely.

Our Grief Care Counselors have seen complicated grief in almost every child and teen that they have counseled since the first COVID-19 restrictions in March 2020. We are all isolated, absent of routine, and witnessing unprecedented uncertainty about the world's future, and in many cases unable to attend traditional memorial services.

Children and teens need this support now more than ever. These complications are occurring regardless of their loved one's cause of death, presence of emotional support, financial means of their family, or their cultural, racial, and ethnic background.

We are currently partnering with school counselors and social workers throughout Brunswick County Schools to identify children who will benefit from virtual grief counseling. Since June, you have helped us provide virtual grief counseling sessions to 18 children in Brunswick County.

It is through the kindness and generosity of supporters, like South Brunswick Islands Rotary Club, that LCFL can continue in our mission to help all children in need, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic.

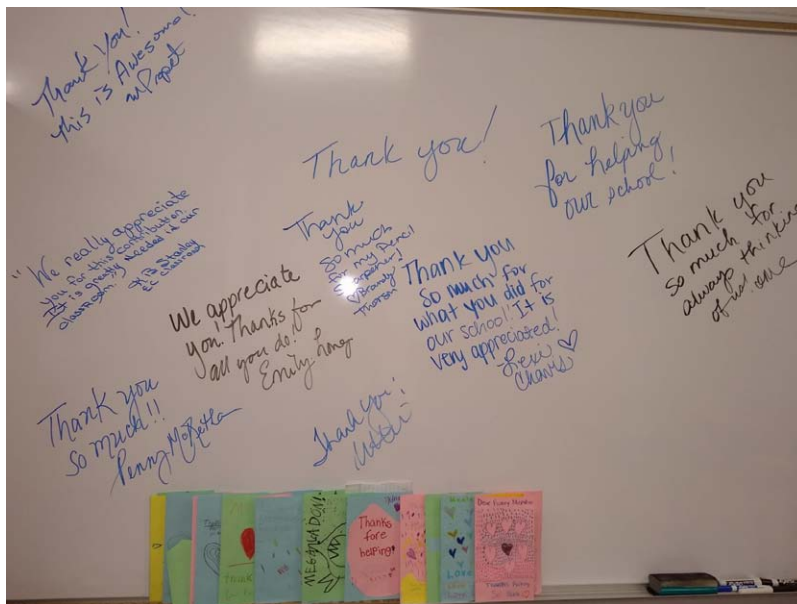

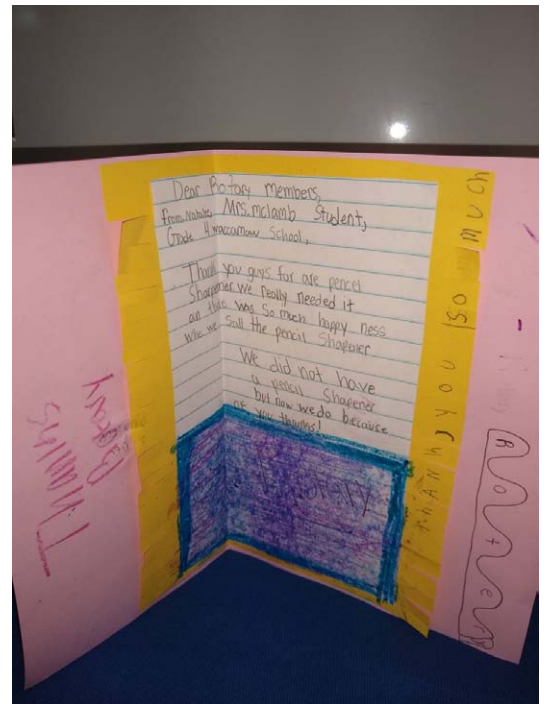
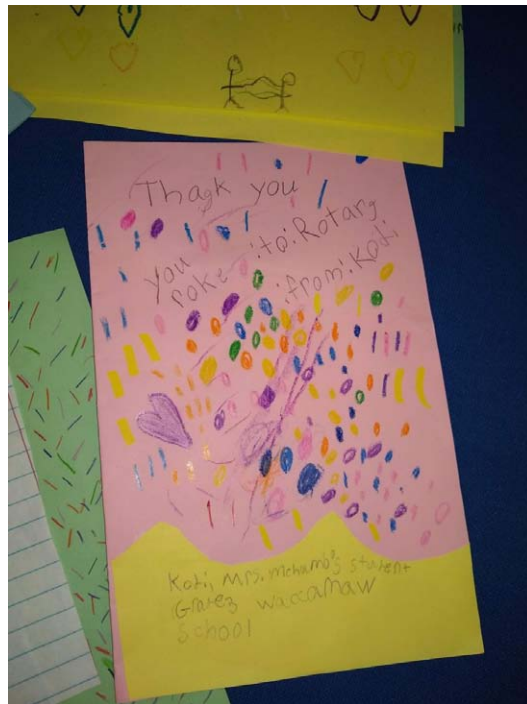

### We need lots of candy!

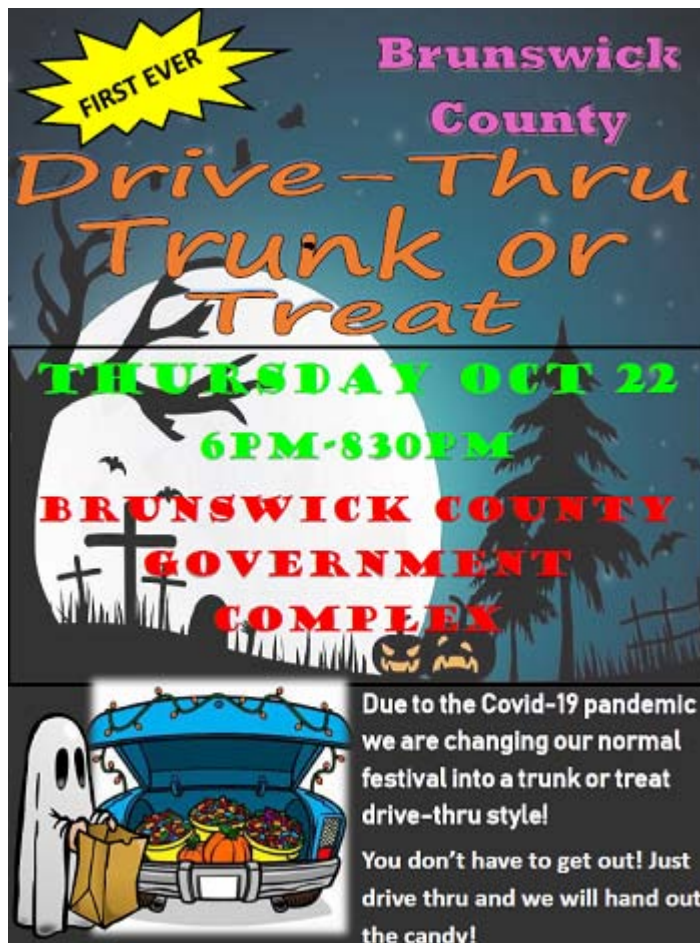
