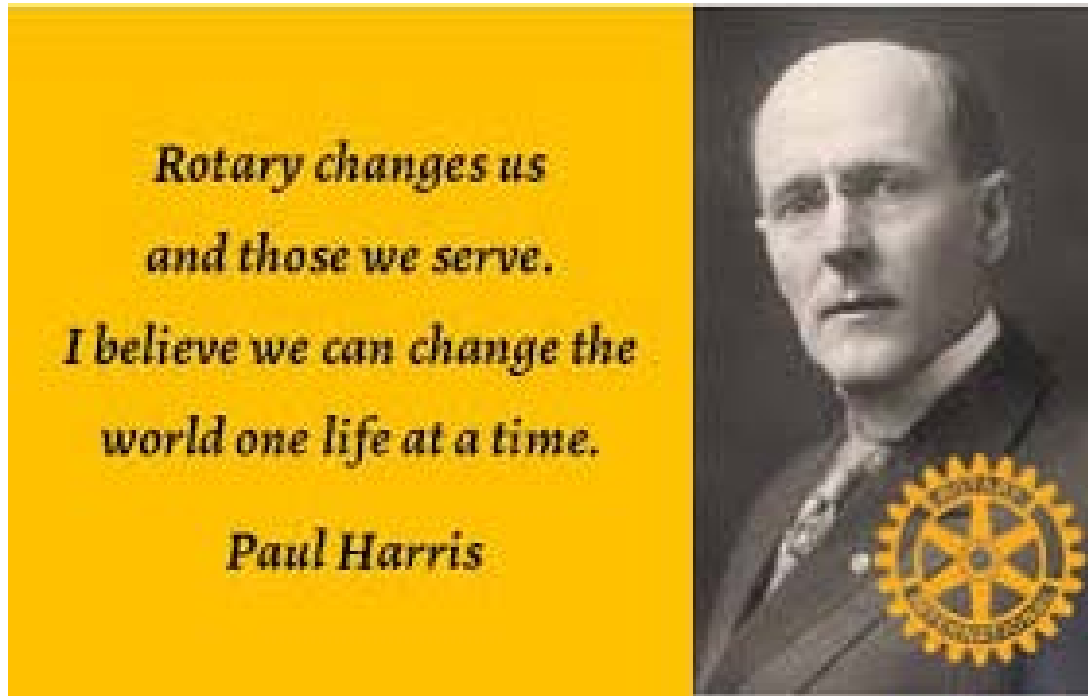

We need lots of candy!

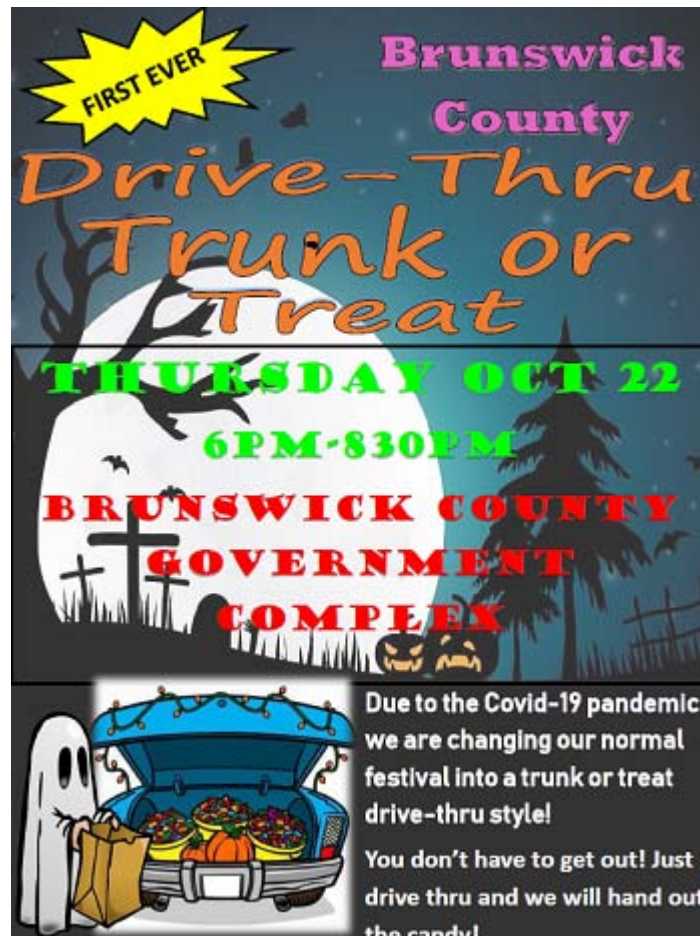
The Service Committee has approved our club's participation in the Brunswick County Drive-Thru Trunk or Treat event on October 22 from 6:30pm - 8:30pm.
