Club Program: Steve McDavid introduced the guest speaker, Mark Lynch who gave a presentation about DACdb, the Rotary District and Club Web Site for Club Management and information storage. Mark used the projection screen in the Country Club Ball Room, throughout his presentation, to show DACdb and to illustrate how to perform the various functions on the DACdb Web site. He began by reminding the membership that each member had an account on the site, then showed the attendees how to access the site. He explained how each member could access their username (your email address) and password (Club ID, found on Rotary magazine address label). Mark then showed how to navigate the site by using the buttons across the top of the screen to go to or return to the **Home** page, **My Data, My Club, District** and **Support**. He showed how to go to the various functions by using the small graphic widget buttons within **My Club & District**. These widgets include 20 topics such as **Club Bulletin, Club Member, Club Attendance, Calendar** etc. Using the left side drop down tool bar you can perform functions within these widget topic areas. Mark asked us to play with the site to learn.
