Log in to DACdb at www.dacdb.com. Click on the My Club tab, then the Engagement Icon. On the left hand side click on enter project activity.

As we look to the last days of this Rotary year, I invite you to join me in matching or surpassing all prior membership and giving to the Rotary Foundation individually and collectively:

- Ensure that your Club has sent the monies to Rotary International for Foundation contributions collected in our Club through dues or other means. First step is Every Rotary Every Year (EREY) - \$100 ever year, then Paul Harris Fellow total of \$1000 to the Foundation, then Paul Harris Society total of \$1000 annually to Major Donor total of \$10,000 given over time.
