Speaker of the Week - Jennifer Plunkett

Jennifer Plunkett has been the Stewardship Coordinator at the North Inlet-Winyah Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve for the past 12 years. She started her marine science adventures at Coastal Carolina University where she became interested in wetland restoration. Following graduation, she worked as a research technician at the University of Georgia Marine Institute, first counting grass shrimp eggs, then being promoted to catching and identifying little fish for projects examining fish use of tidal salt marshes. As exciting as that was, she decided to move on to graduate school at Louisiana State University. There she studied the effects of canal dredging on ecosystem function of the salt marsh edge and landscape patterns of marsh loss, or in other words she spent a lot of time counting *Spartina* stems and digging up ribbed marsh mussels.

As Stewardship Coordinator at the NI-WB NERR, Jennifer works on a variety of projects directed toward the long-term conservation of the North Inlet and Winyah Bay estuaries. These include community education programs such as Winyah Bay Master Naturalist, education and outreach through seminars and publications, monitoring studies such as secretive marsh bird monitoring, and collaborative research projects.
