**50 Things Every Rotarian Should Know About Rotary**

This is the first in an occasional series of articles featuring fifty things every Rotarian should know about Rotary. To start us off, we the review the evolution of Rotary Mottoes. The first motto of Rotary International, ♦He Profits Most Who Serves Best,♦ was approved at the second Rotary Convention in 1911. The phrase had first been first used by a Chicago Rotarian, Art Sheldon, during a speech in 1910 when he said ♦He profits most who serves his fellows best.♦ At about the same time, Ben Collins, President of the Rotary Club of Minneapolis, commented that the proper way to organize a Rotary Club was through the principle his club had adopted, ♦Service, Not Self.♦ These two slogans, slightly modified, were formally approved as the official mottoes of Rotary at the 1950 Convention in Detroit: ♦He Profits Most Who Serves Best♦ and ♦Service Above Self.♦ The 1989 Rotary Council on Legislation established ♦Service Above Self♦ as the principal motto of Rotary, as it best exemplifies the philosophy of unselfish volunteer service.
