Future Weekly Meetings

Please note that all weekly meetings going forward will be in our hybrid format. Starting in September, those meetings will be held at the USCB Hilton Head Campus. More details will follow.

Our Club will hold hybrid meetings until further notice, with the live component being held at SoundWaves, 7 Lagoon Road, through the end of August. Thereafter our meetings will be held at the USCB Hilton Head Campus. ZOOM will remain available for all other attendees. SoundWaves will be open to registered attendees starting at 11:30 AM, with the meeting starting at noon. Parking is available at SoundWaves and in the Coligny parking area across Lagoon Road. Lunch will be provided by Rock Fish at a cost of \$15, if you have registered prior to COB each Tuesday and have made a lunch selection. Payment must be by cash, check or credit/debit card at the meeting. Lunches will NOT be billed.

Please note that our August 5 meeting will be held at the USCB facility off Pope Avenue as SoundWaves will be in use for another event. USCB will be open at 11:30 AM for socializing. There will be a buffet (\$20). We would like to get a general idea of how many members will attend (note that you need not order lunch). Joe Chappell will be providing information regarding sign up. The meeting will begin at noon, and ZOOM will be available for those unable to attend in person.
