#### Future Weekly Meetings

Our Club will hold hybrid meetings until further notice, with the live component being held at SoundWaves, 7 Lagoon Road, through the end of August (with the exception of August 5--see next paragraph). ## This Day in History

July 22, 1934: John Dillinger, America's Public Enemy Number One, was gunned down during a shootout with FBI Agents, who had been alerted that he was hiding in a local movie theater. Dillinger was one of "The Big Three" of American crime in the 1930s along with Machine Gun Kelly and Pretty Boy Floyd. You can catch Dillinger's demise every now and then on Turner Classic Movies.

## 50 Things Every Rotarian Should Know About Rotary

One of the most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics in the world is Rotary's "Four-Way Test" It was created by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in 1932 when he took charge of the Chicago based Club Aluminum Company, then facing bankruptcy. Taylor looked for a way to save the struggling company deeply mired in financial difficulties caused by the Great Depression. He drew up a 24 word code of ethics for all employees to follow in their business and professional lives. That four-way test became the guide for sales, production, advertising and all relationships with customers and suppliers. Taylor credited the company's survival to this simple philosophy. Herbert Taylor became president of Rotary International in 1954. The Four-Way Test was adopted by Rotary in 1943, and has been translated into more than 100 languages.

### The Four-Way Test

Of the things we think, say or do

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
