This Day in History

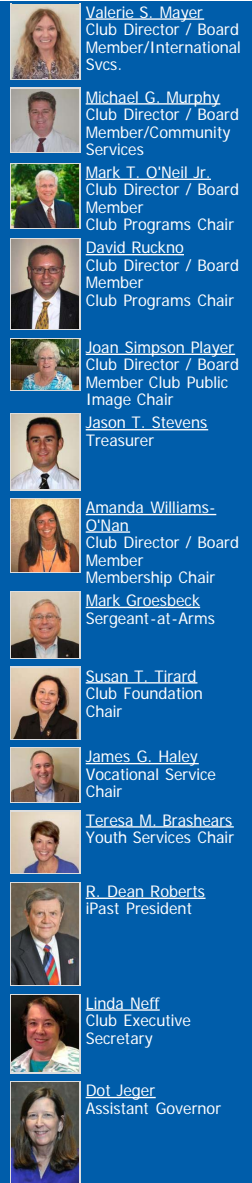
August 12, 1981: Computer giant IBM Corporation introduces its first personal computer. Born on this date: In 1889, Zerna Sharp, creator and co-author with William Grey of the Dick and Jane reading primer series.

Famous Rotarians

Charles H. Mayo, a member of the Rotary Club of Rochester, Minnesota was a founder of the prestigious Mayo Clinic. Charles Mayo was born in Rochester in 1865 and was graduated from Northwestern University in 1888 with a medical degree. After years in private practice, he co-founded the Mayo Clinic in 1919 as a not-for-profit group practice. The Clinic is generally recognized as the first integrated group medical practice in the United States. Today, the Mayo Clinic is respected as one of the world's foremost medical treatment and research institutions. Within Charles Mayo's lifetime, the Clinic registered more than one million patients. He died in Chicago in 1939 survived by two sons, both of whom worked at the world-famous institution founded by their father.
