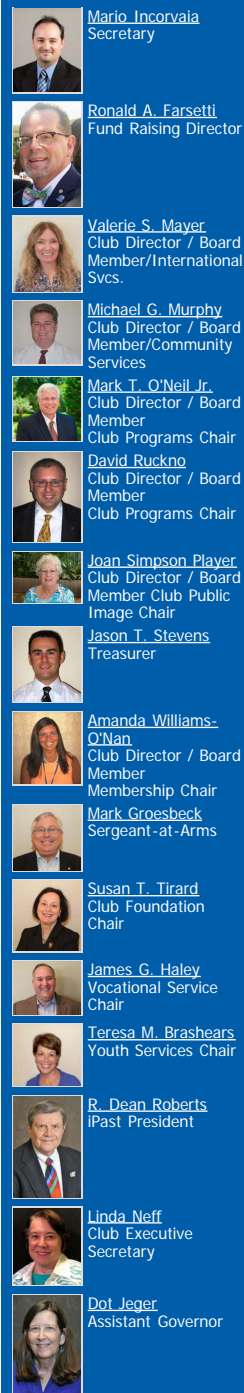
Invite Your Friends to Attend!
