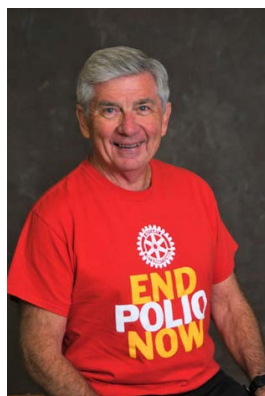

Tremendous strides have been made in recent years, with a very small number of new cases being diagnosed in countries ravaged by conflict or suffering from rudimentary health care systems. The current state of club meetings has resulted in the fund raising component of Bernie's Polio Plus presentation differing from prior years. He has established a **500 Mile Polio Walk/Run Challenge** to help District clubs meet their Polio Plus goals for the year and he does all the work!! Bernie's goal is to walk/run 500 miles during October and November, our District's designated Polio Plus months. 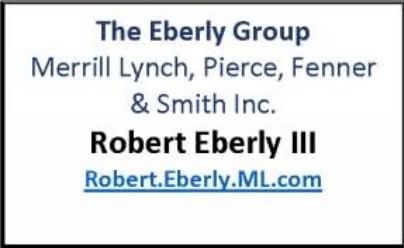
