She will also touch on The Conversation Project, a program that facilitates conversations with loved ones regarding personal wishes in a medical emergency situation.

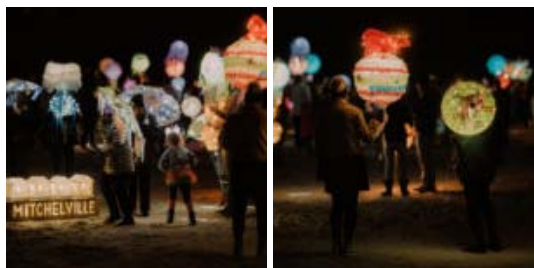

## 50 Things Every Rotarian Should Know About Rotary

This is one of an occasional series of articles featuring 50 things every Rotarian should know about Rotary. The official Rotary flag was adopted by Rotary International at its 1929 Convention in Dallas, Texas. It consists of a white field with the official wheel emblem emblazoned in gold in the center. The four spaces on the rim of the wheel are colored royal blue, and the words "Rotary" and "international" appear in gold at the top and bottom of the wheel. In 1922, an earlier version of a Rotary flag was carried to the south Pole by Admiral Richard Byrd, a member of the Rotary Club of Winchester, Virginia. Four years later, he carried that flag on his expedition to the North Pole. The official flag is always prominently displayed at Rotary's world headquarters, as well as at all conventions and official events of Rotary International.
