This Week's Meeting

This week's program will be presented by Darlene Schuetz, Director of Community Relations for Hospice Care of the Lowcountry. Ms. Schuetz will share strategies for being prepared when medical emergencies befall a family member or loved one. For example, Smart 911 is an excellent tool to prepare ahead for an emergency. Pertinent information provided in advance is already in the EMS system whenever they are called to a medical emergency. She will also touch on The Conversation Project, a program that facilitates conversations with loved ones regarding personal wishes in a medical emergency situation.

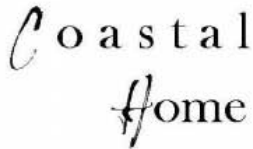
