This 13 minute video celebrates those citizens among us who volunteer their time and expertise to help their fellow citizens in times of need: "Northwest Connecticut firefighter and ambulance services depend heavily on well-trained volunteers. Many of our more than 40 local emergency service organizations are staffed by people who make a living doing something else. They include teachers, small business owners, trades people, contractors, town employees, delivery and retail workers, landscapers, artists, engineers, hairdressers, retirees, and students. These people donate their time, money and talents, and often risk their lives to keep our communities safe.

The film highlights the hard work, training and dedication of these courageous local men and women.
