Last Week's Program:

Guy Rovezzi invited Cynthia Rabinowitz the executive director of the Northwest Conservation District to speak to us about the District and it was an informative and engaging presentation.

Cynthia explained initially a bit of her own history and in particular, concepts which influenced her thinking. The Gaia hypothesis which specifies that life on the planet maintains an equilibrium and the concept of Permaculture both have informed her life's work.

Some of the specific aspects of Permaculture discussed were the Soil Food Web, the significant importance of wetlands, the interconnectedness of life on earth, and the real consequences of climate change with her notably pointing out the correlation between food prices and oil prices.

She then discussed the mission of the Northwest Conservation District and her leadership thereof.
