**Program:** Doctor Kealoha Freidenburg of the Madison Land Conservation Trust was established in 1964 and was the first land trust in CT. It includes 225 parcels, 1750 acres and 35-40 miles of trails on 22 properties (including Ben's former property it turns out!) – they offer educational programs given by experts incluging mushroom walks, wildflower walks, bug walks, amphibian walks, history walks which cover some of the history of Madison and bird walks.
