
HAPPY DOLLARS

TODAY'S PROGRAM: A presentation was made by Ted Calvert about Smith Robinson who was a long time Healdsburg resident. Smith became known as Smitty and took it upon himself to write letters to soldiers in WW2 and Korea so that they would have communication from home and know that they were appreciated. He was personally handling 300 letters a month at one point before he got help. During Korea he spearheaded the adoption of the 1st Battalion, 3rd Infantry of the US Army. His life was honored on "This Is Your



Life" in 1955. The Healdsburg High School Gym is named in his honor. Notable quote from Smitty – "Be useful, that is the important thing".
