Tony introduced the numerous public health benefiting activities that his California Special District does with funding from annual property tax bills. He then went into expert detail about home / structure inspection and rodent exclusion best practices.

Do's from Tony's presentation:

- Keep trees 4' + back from structures
- Consider adding steel wool with gap sealing foams
- Use very small amount of peanut butter with snap traps
- Club member noted that cotton balls also work with snap traps!
- Wear gloves when loading traps (they will smell you were there otherwise)
- Know that they are neophobic don't change their route too much if you want to trap them!
- Clean up after sealing the structure 1:9 bleach water and a spray bottle
- Know that Leptospirosis and Sal Manila are spread by these animals along their paths
- Know that effective anticoagulation baits are banned; also effective on birds of prey, unfortunately

Ways to identify rodents

- Mice: get through <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> holes!
- Norway rat: short-ish tail
- Roof rat: long tail (climbers!)
- Mouse scat: rice
- Norway rat scat: blunt
- Roof rat scat: tapered
