Joanne shared that 7 or 8 days after the fire the famous banyan tree is growing new roots. There is a need to find long term housing for the residents who lost their homes. They feel it will be 10 years to come back to where it was prior to the fire. Menlo Park, Fire Station, donated a truck to Maui fire dept. Bill B. asked if it is too soon to visit Maui and Joanne said no, they welcome all visitors.

Member Bios:

Nancy R - Joined Rossmoor Rotary in 2005 and has lived in Rossmoor for 35 years. Nancy was born on Labor Day on a rainy day in Phoenix. She was a Girl Scout, played violin and danced. Went to AZ State and was Chemistry major. She became a patent researcher and after taking a class with an introduction to computers had a job as a patent expert for computers and became a patent agent. Nancy worked for law firms as a patent expert. Nancy *served* as the President of the Golden Rain Foundation.

Eddie has traveled to Ethiopia and Guatemala as a dentist and had valuable experiences on those trips.


