### **PROGRAM**

Claire W. President of the Rossmoor Fund. Claire is always a welcome guest giving our members an update of the actions of the fund. She has been a 16-year volunteer for the fund. The fund provides needed help for residents who are having financial and other life altering issues. Contact to the fund is made through the counseling office. Applications for assistance are made simple with only a one-page application form. Income eligibility is \$35,000 for a single person, and \$70,000 per couple. The Rossmoor fund tries to say yes more than no. Claire described a couple of situations that greatly improved the lives of Rossmoorians in need of assistance.

The Rossmoor Fund is a 501(c)3 non-profit that has been in existence since 2010. By 2022 750 individual gifts totaling \$1 million have been made.

The Fund has a board of 10 volunteers committed to providing a better life for our residents each bringing a particular skill to the fund. All donations to the fund are tax deductible. Claire praised our supportive community for their continued financial support.
