PROGRAM

John R. presented the Annual report to members of the accomplishments of the Rossmoor Rotary Foundation last year. There is often confusion about two separate legal entities, i.e., the Rossmoor Rotary Club, and the Rossmoor Rotary Foundation. John explained. The Club is part of Rotary International, District 5160 (covering the area from Weed to San Ramon), and Fab 5 (Lafayette, Lamorinda Sunrise, Moraga, Orinda, and Rossmoor). Our Rotary Foundation is a "California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation. It is a 501(c)3 non-profit with the purpose of funding local and international charities. Contributions to the Foundation are

tax-deductible, not so the Club. RRF is totally independent of the Club. There are 12 members of the Foundation: 3 Officers and 9 Trustees.

Last year the Foundation funded \$145,150 in grants to local charities. Of special importance is that donations to the Foundation by Club members totaled \$61,000. Administrative costs were 0.4%. Notable fund-raising events are the annual Cancer, Alzheimer, and Parkinson's "Gala," and See's holiday candy sale.

How we can contribute. Any "happy dollars" over \$50 goes to the Foundation. Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from IRA"s is another, bequests, and cash are also ways to contribute.

Any member can propose a grant and submit a grant application for a cause he/she thinks worthwhile. The Foundation Grants Committee review and recommend to the Board what is submitted.

Finally, ALL CLUB MEMBERS are members of the Foundation. They can attend Foundation Board meetings on the third Wednesday of the month and participate in discussions, although they cannot vote.


