Flag Salute leader was Lance Cavalieri. We hadn't seen Lance for quite some time, Doesn't he seem a little fuzzy :)




Today's song, "Fly Me to the Moon", was chosen because today's program is all about the moon and the stars. We had a special dancer today, all the way
