Jan. 17 2:30-5 pm wine reception at Ruby Hill Winery for Orrin Mahoney. RSVP to Goud.

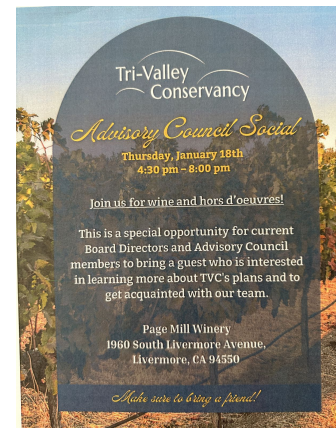
The last Wednesday of the month, our weekly meeting will take place at a local winery. On Jan.31st it will be Del Valle Winery on Tesla Road near Mines Road.
