Students of the Month recognized 3 students from LHS. Ms. Mohammed, the principal, gave a raving review for the three individuals receiving the award:



Our speaker today: Jay Davis introduced our speaker who was Dr. Susan Zimmerman, Geochemist at LLNL Center for Accelerator Mass Spectrometry, was introduced by Jay Davis. Her topic was "dating the white sand's footprintsâ€, which included discussions about the dating process, but also about the implications of the results. She explained the "Clovis first†theory and how the dates of the white sands footprints pre-dated the clovis theory by 7000 years. She also spoke about the near religious level of loyalty some anthropologists have to the â€current accepted theory†of the origin of mankind on the American and South American continents.
