He was met by Delinda and husband, President Kay Doxilly and George Bruce. Delinda and family will host Noah in their home.



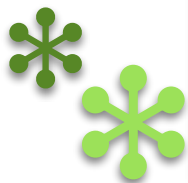
STUDENT OF THE MONTH AWARDS
