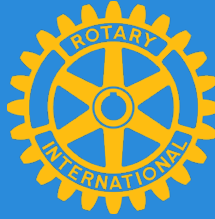

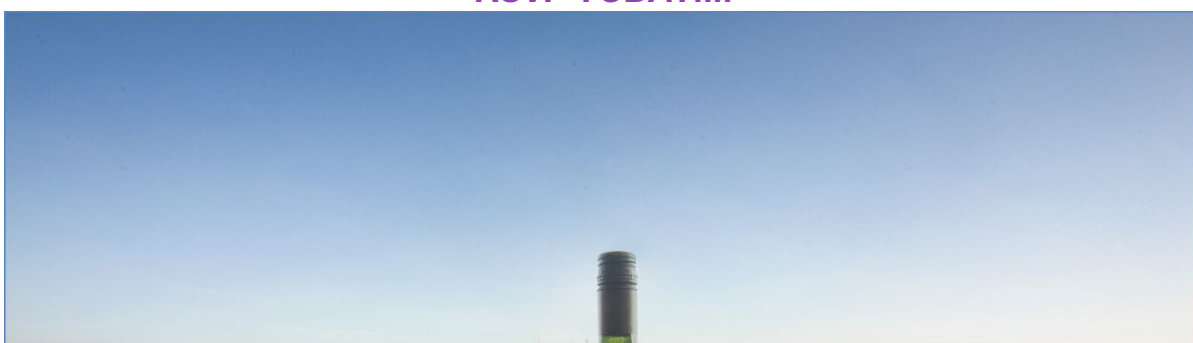

A Rotary Minute: Helping Meet Human Needs in Sudan



HELPING MEET HUMAN NEEDS IN SUDAN

Rotarians from the Rotary Clubs of Austin, South Austin and Westlake spent years fundraising to collect enough money to construct a hospital (opened in 2010), drill and build multiple water wells and provide generators to sustain their operation in Nubia, Northern Sudan.

Rotary International provides medicine and supplies to continue operating this hospital, which is the only source of medical care for ~17,000 villagers annually.

Rise Against Hunger



The Rotary Club of Austin (RCA) hosted its annual **Rise Against Hunger (RAH)** service project on Saturday, February 17th.

RCA members, family and friends were joined by volunteers from six other Rotary Clubs; and everyone had fun and worked together to package **23, 328** dry food meals that will be distributed to feed hungry families world-wide!

The Rotary Club of Austin held its first RAH event in 2016, and it's become one of the Club's most highly anticipated annual service opportunities ever since! **Together, we've packed 196,344 meals** (including those on 2/17/24) which have been delivered to hungry people in Guatemala, Honduras, Cambodia, Eswatini, Haiti and Tanzania.
