A Rotary Minute: World Water Day (March 22, 2024)



WORLD WATER DAY (MARCH 22, 2024)

World Water Day is an annual United Nations (UN) observance day held every March 22nd that highlights the importance of fresh water. The day is used to advocate for the sustainable management of freshwater resources.

The theme of each year focuses on topics relevant to clean water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH), which is in line with the targets of Sustainable Development Goal 6. The UN World Water Development Report (WWDR) is released each year around World Water Day.

World Water Day began in 1993 and has become an annual UN observance day that highlights the importance of freshwater. The theme of each March 22nd focuses on topics relevant to clean water, sanitation and hygiene.
