Dianne Andrews is an award-winning business leader, TV host, author, professional speaker, community activist, health care expert and philanthropist. She graduated from high school as valedictorian and college at the young age of 19 with a B.S. in Mathematics, Chemistry with a minor in Computer Science. Even with her father passing her freshman year and a month later, her mom was struck by a car, causing her to be physically challenged for the remainder of her life. After graduating, she went to work for IBM in Endicott, NY, then IBM/NASA at Johnson Space Center in Houston, TX, working as a computer programmer on the Space Shuttle project. After a year, she was promoted to be the second black woman Systems Engineer in the state of Texas.

While at IBM, she held several executive management positions and obtained her MBA. During her management tenure there, Andrews was the first black woman Marketing Manager in the state of New Jersey. She was also the second black woman executive manager in the state of Connecticut. She worked with business giants such as Avis Rent A Car, Yale University, University of Connecticut, BMW, Mercedes-Benz, Kaiser, Sharp, Exxon, Alcoa Aluminum, Minolta, and LG -traveling worldwide. Her Motto: "Leave a path of goodness for others to follow."
