- November 9



Rotary History in Disaster Relief

In 2012, Shelter Box became Rotary's first Project Partner and remains Rotary International's only one official charity for disaster relief. Our club is a ShelterBox Hero club, which means we have donated at least \$1,000 during the Rotary year. Have you ever wondered why ShelterBox is so entwined with Rotary?



Shelter Box was started in 2000, as a millennium project of the Rotary Club of Helston-Lizard, in Cornwall, UK. To date, *every* Shelter Box affiliate has been started by Rotary or Rotaract

members. The first distribution of 143 Shelter Boxes was sent to victims of the 2001 Gujarat earthquake, while in 2024, ShelterBox is working in Morocco, Libya, Somalia, Turkey, Syria, Pakistan, Mozambique, Cameroon, Burkina Faso, Yemen, Ethiopia and Ukraine. Rotary has been instrumental to Shelter Box's growing ability to help people displaced by natural disaster or conflict.
