## Rotary History- The Four-Way Test

As Rotarians, we are probably all familiar with the traditional Four-Way test:

1. Is it the truth?
2. Is it fair to all concerned?
3. Will it build good will and better friendships?
4. Is it beneficial to all concerned?



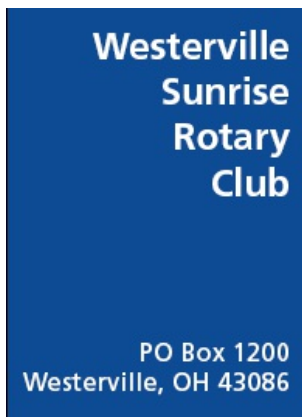
Did you know that the 4-way test was written in 1932 by Mr. Herbert Taylor as

a simple ethics yardstick when he was asked to take over the Club Aluminum Products Company, then in dire financial straits? Mr. Taylor wanted something that every employee could memorize and take to heart in all their dealings.

Mr. Taylor was member of the Rotary Club of Chicago, later an international director of Rotary and RI President (1954-1955). Mr. Taylor offered the 4-way test to Rotary in the 1940s, and it was adopted by Rotary in 1943. Mr Taylor even gave Rotary the copyright for the 4-way test, retaining the rights to use it for himself, the Club Aluminum Products Company and the Christian Workers Foundation.
