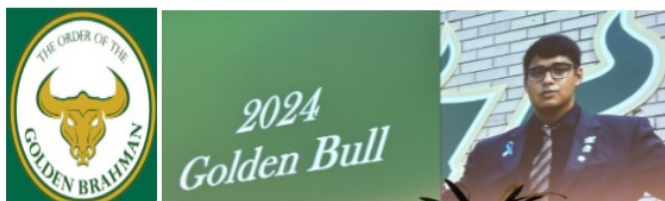
Congratulations Rotaract - USF 2024 Awards
